Grooved Walls

This is a very worthwhile area offering a variety of climbing, but the conditions need to be right. Best visited on summer mornings, when it will get the sun. Approaches can sometimes be a bit overgrown and jungle-like, although abseil approaches are very easily accessible by staying on the path that leads round the top of the quarry.

Flagellator VD

13m The blocky gully that runs to the left of a drill mark.

Fuzzy Bees E35c

Climb the thin leftward trending crack then pass the top overhang on its left edge.

Touché Turtle HS

The vertical crack just right.

Trumpton \$4a

Climb the groove and the deep crack on its right.

Aethelred E25b *

Good climbing up the poorly-protected right arête.

Aethelred Groove HS 4b *

Climb the second deep V-groove using the wide crack in the left wall.

The Creaking Fossil HVS 4c

14m Climb the blunt right arête of the V-groove via an unattractive, fern-filled crack.

Sideline VD •

15m Step left onto a large 'poised' block, then continue up the rib to the top.

Adam's Groove HS 4a

The deep groove, finishing on the right.

Adam's Wall HS 4a

Climb a short chimney to a ledge on the right, then move up to a triangular niche on the arête. Make a hard step up to a small ledge and finish direct.

Brush Off VD

15m Climb the right side of obvious blocks to a ledge, then continue to the top of a three block pedestal and finish up the deep crack.

12 Deeper and Deeper HS

15m After an awkward start, climb the deep chimney on the left of the detached pillar and finish on the right.



13 Letter-box HVS 5a >

15m Pleasant climbing up the front face of the detached pillar. A problem start leads to good holds up the wide face of the detached tower.

14 Headspin Cleft VS 5a

12m Climb the wall to the V-groove behind the pillar, then continue straight up this. All in the Mind, E2 5b (1997), steps right at a ledge below the V-groove, then step right to gain the arête and follow this to the top.

15 Vlad the Impaler 54a 12m The blocky groove.

16 Walking on Glass E4 6b ★

15m An excellent climb offering strenuous and technical, but well protected climbing. Climb to the prominent square-cut overhang at mid-height on the right, step left on to a block, then climb directly up (peg at a small overlap). Undercut the overlap rightwards (peg) and finish direct, slapping wildly up the right arête.

17 Cutting Edge VS 4c

Scramble over ledges and finish up the wide crack.

Black Arm 54a IIm The deep corner groove.

19 New Groove HS 4b

12m Follow the right-leading groove in the centre of the wall, past a small overlap.

20 Sparkin' Bush HVS 5a *

15m Surmount the initial bulge, and place good protection in the left crack, then continue up the face on hidden holds. A surprisingly good route.

Blue Strawberry 54a

Climb the centre of the detached tower.

22 Chopper Chimney 54a

12m The crack/chimney behind the detached tower. Finish up the blunt arête on the right.



23 Guillotine E3 5c * * *

13m Climb the finger crack past a peapod with a wedged block at its top. A classic struggle, but low in its grade.

24 The Cutter VS 4c

The corner.
